WHO WE ARE

The Denver Community Kollel is an institute for advanced Torah study whose scholars are dedicated to serving the educational and spiritual needs of all Jews throughout the greater Denver area.

OUR MISSION

Our mission is twofold:

- To prepare our scholars for their future roles as leaders of the Jewish community.
- To share the beauty of Judaism and Torah study in particular with Jews of all backgrounds.

OUR STAFF

The Kollel is currently comprised of five scholars who study Torah in-depth under the direction of Kollel Deans Rabbi Shachne Sommers and Rabbi Aron Yehuda Schwab. The scholars dedicate much of their day to furthering their Torah study and knowledge. They dedicate their evenings and other hours during the week to studying one-on-one with community members and giving classes.

Rabbi Moshe Heyman, the Kollel's Director of Programming, oversees and coordinates all of the Kollel's community programs, while exploring and developing new opportunities for Torah study throughout the greater Denver area.

Rabbi Mordechai Fleisher, the Kollel's Director of Operations, oversees and directs the administrative operations of the Kollel. He is also a Senior Educator for the Kollel, delivering his dynamic and informative classes throughout Denver.

The Kollel Women's Division, led by the wives of the Kollel scholars, works to bring the beauty of Judaism and Torah to women and their families in particular.



NIGHTLY TORAH STUDY AT THE KOLLEL'S TORAH CENTERS

Jews of all backgrounds study at the Kollel's Torah Centers located on Denver's West Side and in Southeast Denver. The Kollel offers one-on-one study and group study with Kollel scholars.



WEEKLY TORAH CLASSES

Kollel scholars give weekly classes and lectures to small groups on a variety of topics, including Talmud, the Torah Portion, and Jewish Law. Classes are held primarily in the evenings, at the Kollel and in locations throughout Denver.



LEARN 2 LEARN

Jews who want to attain the tools and ability needed to achieve independent Talmud study are given that opportunity at this class. Two tracks, led by Kollel scholars Rabbi Dovid Schwartzberg and Rabbi Eli Mozes meet bi-weekly at the Kollel's Southeast Torah Center, while Kollel Scholar Rabbi Yossi Kaplan delivers the class weekly at the Kollel's West Side Torah Center.





WOMEN'S PARTNERS IN TORAH

Women of all backgrounds study in pairs, in person or over the phone. Students and their mentors study a variety of topics, including Jewish law, family purity, philosophy, and Jewish history.



JEWISH WOMEN'S RENAISSANCE PROJECT

The Kollel's Esti Schwab and Yehudis Heyman lead Denver Jewish women as they join women from all over North America on missions to Israel. The Jewish Women's Renaissance Project (JWRP) runs a highly-subsidized, 10-day, action-packed mission to Israel. Women travel as a group, grow as a group, and continue "their journey" back to their communities as sisters, having shared an incredible experience together. They share a common vision of self-growth and personal development to reach their potential as Jewish women, wives and mothers. To date, JWRP has brought together close to 1,000 women from 20 cities and 6 different countries.

SOUTHEAST WOMEN'S CLASSES

High-level classes from Kollel rabbis and women on Jewish thought provide a bigger, breathtaking picture of Judaism, providing a greater appreciation of a Torah-observant life.



WOMEN'S WELLNESS WORKSHOP

An annual summit for Jewish women highlighting a variety of wellness issues regarding the mind, body and soul, the Women's Wellness Workshop brings together a diverse group of Jewish women to discover new insights into living life - both physical and spiritual - in the most fulfilling fashion possible.



TORAH FOR TYCOONS

This monthly business ethics lunch-and-learn series gives Jewish business professionals the tools to maintain high ethical standards in the workplace. It is unique in that it pairs some of Denver's top Jewish business leaders with Kollel Dean Rabbi Aron Yehuda Schwab and Senior Educator Rabbi Mordechai Fleisher to uncover how the Torah's timeless wisdom can be applied to today's most difficult business-related ethical challenges.



EXECUTIVE LEARNING PROGRAM

Kollel Rabbis Yechiel Erlanger, Moshe Heyman and Mordechai Fleisher gives business professionals with hectic schedules the opportunity to study Torah and learn more about Judaism by studying with them one-on-one in their offices and homes. More than a dozen businessmen participate in this program.



LUNCH-AND-LEARNS

SPEAKER'S BUREAU

HOME STUDY GROUPS
